

Green flag lap





- 1 min will start counting from the last car is on the grid

Grid position










Race start

T1 rejoin




Be aware when rejoining that cars can be exiting the pitlane at the same point.






Flag Signals

The most dangerous flag always prevails!






Yellow Flags




For the safety of our marshals SLOW DOWN.

SINGLE Waved Yellow Reduce your speed. do not overtake, and be prepared to change direction.

Double Waved Yellow Double waved: Reduce your speed significantly, do not overtake, and be prepared to change direction or stop.

Slow down immediately!


No overtaking!

No weaving after going into T11
































Contact



Avoidable contact will NOT be tolerated. Penalties may be applied in the event of any avoidable contact.







FIA ISC Appendix L:

"However, manoeuvres liable to hinder other drivers, such as deliberate crowding of a car beyond the edge of the track or any other abnormal change of direction, are strictly prohibited."

In the event that a fellow competitor has a significant amount of his car alongside yours you must leave him or her racing room.

We take into account various factors including relative car positions.

2025 Driving Standards Guidelines v1

In reviewing incidents, the Stewards are assisted by the Driver Advisor in combination with the series regulations, FIA Regulations (the International Sporting Code (ISC), notably Appendix L, Chapter IV (The Code of Driving Conduct on Circuits)) and all evidence available to them.

The guidelines below are intended to provide a framework for analysing on-track incidents, but it must be noted that these are GUIDELINES, and not regulatory.
