

Race Directors notes Round 5 – Silverstone - V1

Min. sector and lap times in qualifying
 Minimum sector and lap times must be obeyed at all times during Q1 and Q2 (Unless the
 track is declared wet).

Failure to comply may result in the matter being referred to the Stewards for investigation and possible penalties.

Any driver, driving unnecessarily slowly or otherwise impeding other drivers may still be reported to the stewards regardless complying with the minimum lap times.

3. Leaving the boxes

- a. In qualifying sessions, GB3 Championship representatives will be in the pitlane, pulling the cars from the garages and into the working area in order. If a team choose to not start the qualifying at the green light, the car will need to stay in the garage. When the pit exit light goes green the cars can leave the working area.
- b. In race sessions, the Race Director will call the teams on the radio when they can go into the working area. GB3 Championship representatives will then be in the pitlane, pulling the cars from the working area and into the fastlane in order. When the pit exit light goes green the cars can leave the fastlane.
