


### Pit Exit Blend Line

The most dangerous flag always prevails!






# **Yellow Flags**




For the safety of our marshals SLOW DOWN.

**SINGLE Waved Yellow** Reduce your speed. do not overtake, and be prepared to change direction.

**Double Waved Yellow** Double waved: Reduce your speed significantly, do not overtake, and be prepared to change direction or stop.

Slow down immediately!


No overtaking!

# **Safety Car Restart**




No overtaking or overlapping until the Control Line
























#### FIA ISC Appendix L:

"However, manoeuvres liable to hinder other drivers, such as deliberate crowding of a car beyond the edge of the track or any other abnormal change of direction, are strictly prohibited."

In the event that a fellow competitor has a significant amount of his car alongside yours you must leave him or her racing room.

We take into account various factors including relative car positions.

#### **APPENDIX B: STEWARDS PENALTY GUIDELINES**

Stewards have the authority to decide what penalty to enforce in the event of a breach of the FIA International Sporting Code (ISC) and/or the applicable FIA regulations. Stewards retain the discretion to take into account any mitigating and/or aggravating circumstances as well as the nature and location of the Event, to tailor the penalty to the specific situation.

The table below serves as a guideline to assist stewards in determining fines for violations of certain articles of the ISC:

FIA Regulation breached	1 <sup>st</sup> offence	2 <sup>nd</sup> offence*	3 <sup>rd</sup> offence*
Article 12.2.1.f ISC: Any words, deeds or writings that have caused moral injury or loss to the FIA, its bodies, its members or its executive officers, and more generally on the interest of motor sport and on the values defended by the FIA.	€10,000	€20,000 plus 1- month suspension – which is suspended.	€30,000 plus 1-month suspension plus deduction of Championship points.
Article 12.2.1.I ISC: Any Misconduct.  Misconduct is defined under Article 20 of the ISC.	€10,000	€20,000 plus 1- month suspension – which is suspended.	€30,000 plus 1-month suspension plus deduction of Championship points.
Article 12.2.1.n ISC: Any public incitement to violence or hatred.	€10,000	€20,000 plus 1- month suspension – which is suspended.	€30,000 plus 1-month suspension plus deduction of Championship points.
